## Nurturing a Student's Vision Exhibition Guidelines

### Des Moines Arts Festival: June 27-29, 2008

Sponsored by Hubbell Homes in conjunction with the Des Moines Arts Festival and Des Moines Art Center.

#### Eligibility

- Participating schools will be from the Heartland AEA II region.
- Each elementary school may submit four works.
- Each secondary school may submit four works.
- Any **two-dimensional** medium is acceptable.
- Artwork must be created in the 2007-2008 school year.
- **Do not mount or mat artwork.** Des Moines Arts Festival staff will mount submitted artwork.

#### Dimensions

- Elementary school artwork must be no larger than 12" x 18".
- Secondary school artwork must be no larger than 18" x 24".

#### Student Art Entry Form

- Complete form and print a copy for your own records by clicking the "Print Form" button located at the bottom of the document.
- Submit via email by clicking the "Submit" button located at the bottom of the document.

#### Exhibition Labels

- Visit <http://www.desmoinesartsfestival.com/nsv> to access the Exhibition Labels.
- Type student artist information in spaces provided.
- Print three copies using the "Print Form" button located at the top of the document and cut apart.
- Attach one student label to the back of appropriate artwork. Enclose the remaining two student labels in an envelope and attach to the piece.
- Email the label form to the Des Moines Arts Festival by clicking the "Submit Form via Email" button located at the top of the document.

#### Parent Letter

- Visit <http://www.desmoinesartsfestival.com/nsv> to access the Parent Letter.
- Print one letter for each student submitted (maximum of four).
- Give letter to the parent(s) of the student(s) selected to be in the 2008 Nurturing a Student's Vision program.

#### Protection

- Laminate OR wrap works in acetate.
- The exhibit will take place outside under a tent. The Des Moines Art Center, Downtown Events Group and Des Moines Arts Festival are not responsible for lost or damaged artwork.

## **Memberships**

- Each exhibitor will receive a certificate of participation and a Des Moines Art Center student membership at the Visionary Artists Ceremony on Saturday, June 28, at 10:15 a.m. at the Des Moines Arts Festival.
- Participating art teachers will receive a Des Moines Art Center Membership or renewal.
