



Dear Visionary Artist and Parent(s):

Congratulations! We are incredibly pleased your artwork will be on exhibit during the 2024 Des Moines Arts Festival® as part of the Student Art Exhibition presented by GreenState Credit Union.

In addition to your work being on display during the award-winning Festival, you are invited to the **Visionary Artists Ceremony** on Saturday, June 29th, 2024, on the Hy-Vee Main Stage (located on the West side of 12th St., between Locust St. and Grand Ave). This year, the ceremony will be divided into two sessions by grade.

- If your child is a **Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup>-grade student**, the ceremony will begin at **11:30 a.m.** We ask that you please arrive at 11:15 a.m.
- If your child is in **5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade**, the ceremony will begin at **1:15 p.m.** We ask that you please arrive at 1:00 p.m. for this ceremony.

During each session, student artists will be called on stage to receive an achievement award in recognition of their artistic efforts.

Parents, along with this letter we have included a card to be cut out and completed listing your student artist's name and school. Please bring the completed card with you to your ceremony session on Saturday. Each student will give the card to a staff member at the entrance to the stage and have their name and the school announced as they walk across the stage.

The Student Art Exhibition presented by GreenState Credit Union features artwork from over 400 students at 100 different schools throughout central Iowa. The exhibition is located at the corner of 13th and Locust St., and can be viewed during regular Festival hours on Friday, June 28th from 11 a.m. - 10 p.m., Saturday, June 29th from 11 a.m.- 10 p.m., and Sunday, June 30th from 11 a.m.- 4:30 p.m.

Following the festival, all student artworks will be transferred to various GreenState Credit Union locations around central Iowa to be on display until September 4th. The exact location of your student's artwork will be available on our website after the festival. Student artwork will be available for pick up this September at the Student Art Exhibition Reception. Additional details (including date and location) will be sent to you and your student's teacher this spring. Artists may also receive their recognition award at that time if they are unable to attend the June ceremony.

After the fall reception, any remaining artwork can be picked up at Mainframe Studios (900 Keosauqua Way, #431, Des Moines) through October 11, 2024. Pick-up times are Mon – Fri 8 a.m. - 6:30 p.m., Sat - Sun, 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. Artwork will be organized by grade level, so please be prepared to provide your student's grade from the 2023-2024 school year. If your artwork is not here, please check with your art teacher, as they may have signed it out at the fall reception. All leftover artworks will be recycled after October 11, 2024.
